ACCESSIBILITY

The Albert Dock is fully accessible, both inside the quay and on exterior walkways. Guide and hearing dogs are welcome on the Dock site and in our venues; toilet and baby changing facilities are available in The Colonnades and there are eight disabled parking bays.

PARKING

The Albert Dock has a number of pay and display spaces, but these are limited. Extra parking is available at both Liverpool ONE and the 24-hour car park adjacent to the Arena and Convention Centre Liverpool.

HOW TO FIND US

ON FOOT

The Albert Dock is a 20 minute walk from Liverpool Lime Street station, and can be reached through Liverpool ONE. You can also reach us along the river walkway from the Museum of Liverpool and Cruise Terminal.

BY BUS

The C1, C2, C3, C4 and C5 bus services stop at the Albert Dock, or you can walk to the Dock from Liverpool ONE bus station, where other services start and finish.

BY CAR

From the M62 motorway, follow the brown tourist signs for 'Liverpool Waterfront' or 'Albert Dock.' From the M53, head northbound from Ellesmere Port through the Wallasey (Kingsway) Tunnel. Merge onto Scotland Road and turn right at the traffic lights, then follow the brown tourist signs to 'Liverpool Waterfront' or 'Albert Dock'. For the A41 and Birkenhead, follow signs through the Queensway Tunnel.
